Dr. S.P. Singh College of Teacher Education, Motihari, East Champaran, Bihar was established in 2008. The College is recognised by National Council for Teacher Education, New Delhi vide file number BR-S/N-35/2008/1951 Eastern Regional Committee National Council for Teacher Education, Bhubaneswar.

Prompted by fast multiplying needs of the hour, "**Dr. S.P. Singh College of Teacher Education**" has been in efforts to cope-up with the prevailing set-up of the people's mind to prepare a solid base for their children so as to enable them to match with national and international competitive atmosphere.

The scarcity of trained teachers is quite evident in Bihar. Turning to the eastern region, we have found that the neighbouring states like Bengal, Orissa and other states, do have a huge demand of such hands but at present there is no way to get trained teachers for teaching in Government Sector with similar situation prevailing in Private Sector too. In near future, the National Council for Teacher Education is thinking of improvement in Indian Education pattern for meeting competition on global scale. To add to the intensity and gravity of the problem aforesaid, the private sector, affiliated and non affiliated institutions up to + 2 level, will also make it mandatory on the teachers to be appointed that they must be trained as per the pattern mentioned above. In view of the situation prevailing on the national and international horizon, "**Dr. S.P. Singh College of Teacher Education**" is training in the way to produce world-class teachers. This institute will leave no stone unturned to achieve the goal by providing all facilities to the trainees in right earnest.

In keeping with the development and process oriented objectives of Teacher Training Programmes in this area, we aim at developing the student teachers concept, competencies, attitudes and skills related to implementation of an appropriate curriculum based on child-centred activity and play-based approach to Teacher Training Programme.

The area encompassed in the curriculum would be cognitive and language development, health and nutrition, socio-emotional development, physical and psychometry development, aesthetic development, creativity and play, programme, planning and school organisation, community mobilization and participation. Within these broad guidelines the curriculum is flexible to accommodate different approaches and schools of thought on Teacher Training Programme for starting a Teacher Training Education in Bihar.

RECOGNITION

Dr. S.P. Singh College of Teacher Education, Motihari, East Champaran, Bihar was established in 2008. It is recognised by Eastern Regional Committee National Council for Teacher Education (NCTE) Govt. of India vide file no. BR-S/N-35/2008/1951 dated 26 October, 2009 for conducting B Ed course of secondary (level) of 1 year duration of an annual intake of 100 (one hundred) from the academic session 2009-2010.

Dr. S.P. Singh College of Teacher Education is in a well furnished building with well equipped laboratories, library and other essential facilities as required by the National Council for Teacher Education. It is established in the peaceful area and is well communicated from Railway & Road. Nearest Railway station BAPUDHAM MOTIHARI is 3.5 K.M. & MOTIHARI bus stand is 4 K.M. from the college.

Eligibility for Admission

Candidates with at least fifty percent marks either in the Bachelor's Degree and/or in the Master's degree or any other qualification equivalent thereto, are eligible for admission to the programme. Admission will be granted on the basis of written test.

RESERVATION OF SEATS

The college follows strictly the policy of reservation of the Govt. of Bihar. In case, there is no candidate from reserved categories, the seats will be offered to the candidates of other categories. Over and above reserved seats, supernumerary seats will be available to the Management of the college. Candidates interested for admission against supernumerary seats are advised to obtain the Quota Form from the college office and submit it back.

FOREIGN STUDENT & NRI

Seats are also reserved for Foreign and NRI student as per direction from Govt. of Bihar. They should have proper equivalent qualification approved by the Govt. of India, Ministry of HRD

Application for admission test should be made in the prescribed form which can be obtained from the college office or aforesaid modes. Application received after the closing date or incomplete in any respect will be rejected.

PHYSICAL FITNESS

The applicant should have good health and free from any mental and infectious diseases. Therefore, the candidates will have to submit medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner.

APPLICATION FORM

The prospectus and the application form for admission shall be available at the counter of the College on all working days. Prospectus with application form is priced Rs. 500/- (Rs. Five Hundred Only). This can be obtained from the college counter.

Acceptance of the application form is subject to payment of Rs. 500/- (Rs. Five Hundred) in the form of Demand Draft in favour of "Dr. S.P. Singh College of Teacher Education" at Motihari.

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION

The application form should be carefully filled up by the candidate as per instruction mentioned therein. Incomplete forms may be rejected.

The candidates are required to submit their application form either personally or by Registered Post with one self addressed envelop with requisite stamp for registered -correspondence, on / before the date fixed for it in the advertisement.

ENCLOSURES WITH APPLICATION FORM

All filled up application forms for admission test shall be accompanied :-

- (i) Photocopy of all certificates and marksheets (from matric to higher education).
- (ii) Photocopy of certificate of matriculation or equivalent examination, for proof of age.
- (iii) Photocopy of C.L.C./M.L.C./D.L.C. according to qualification.
- (iv) Photocopy of character certificate.
- (v) One self addressed envelope with stamp worth Rs. 30/- for correspondence.
- (vi) Two Passport size and one stamp size recent colour photographs.
- (vii) Photocopy of Caste certificate (in case of SC / ST / EBC/OBC women/ BC /Handicapped)
- (viii) Photocopy of medical certificate from a Civil Surgeon practitioner (in case of physical handicapped).

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The college will take an entrance test. The merit list of successful candidates will be drawn up on the basis of the marks obtained in the entrance test.

The result of successful candidates will be published on

the Notice Board of the college and on the college web-site. The candidates whose name appears on the merit list must report within the prescribed dates to deposit their fees and for securing admission. The selected candidates must bring their original certificates for verification. Failure to report in time along with original certificates may lead to cancellation of selection. The candidates have to report to the admission-in-charge who would sign an acknowledgement slip and give date and time after verifying that the candidate's name appears on the merit list. Admission will be offered to candidates as per serial number in merit and waiting list subject to availability of seat. After his/her certificate are checked to be in order, the admission-in-charge would then give the candidate an authority to deposit fees.

The candidate must deposit the fees on or before the cut-off date. Admission won't be guaranteed if fees are not paid on or before the cut-off date.

The merit/waiting list shall be displayed on the Notice Board of the college and the Notice Board of the website.

The candidates are advised to see the Notice Board of the college on or after the date fixed for putting up the merit / waiting list.

CANCELLATION / REFUSAL OF ADMISSION

- (i) Candidate will have to produce all original marksheets, certificates and testimonials at the time of counselling for admission.
- (ii) Admission of any candidate is provisional and may be cancelled if any discrepancy is detected or the candidate fails to comply with the rules & regulations, and other conditions as laid down by the college.
- (iii) Admission even after confirmation may be cancelled in case the students don't attend 75% classes.
- (iv) In case a candidate fails to report on the due date with the required documents and fee for admission, he/she will forfeit his/her claim for admission and the seat so render vacant will be allotted to other candidates.

- (v) Rules of eligibility are followed strictly. The college, however, reserves the right to refuse admission to any candidate without assigning any reason.

FEES AND OTHER CHARGES

The amount of tuition fees and other charges will be fixed by the college authority each year. The amount of fees, once realized, will not be refunded in any case. The Fee structure of college for 2009-10 session:

Admission fee: Rs. 5,000/-

College Fee: Rs. 20,000/-

Development, Maintenances & Utility fees: Rs. 30,000/-

A total of Rs. 55,000/- will be paid at the time of Admission in form of Demand Draft in favour of Executive Director, Dr. S.P. Singh College of Teacher Education payable at Motihari.

DUES

All dues to the college should be cleared by students before they are permitted to appear at Annual/Final examination.

FINES

Students shall have to pay on demand, any fine imposed on him or the cost of any damage or loss of books of library, equipments or other properties of the college. Failure to do so may result in the expulsion of the student from the institution any time.

STRIKING OFF ROLL

The name of the student may be struck off the rolls on account of the following:

- (i) His/her own request endorsed by his parent/guardian.
- (ii) Continued absence without obtaining leave for six consecutive days.
- (iii) Irregular attendance.

- (iv) Poor progress at studies.
- (v) Non - payment of any fee/fine as levied by college authority for 20 days after the last date of payment. The principal however, may grant not more than 10 days of grace in deserving cases on application by the parents/guardians.
- (vi) Any act of indiscipline.

EXAMINATIONS

- (i) *Each student compulsorily has to take examination conducted by the college time to time. Passing the sent-up examination held by the college is a must to appear at the University Examination. A minimum of 75% attendance is a must for Sent-up Examination.*
- (ii) *Each student shall take the respective examination conducted by the university and Department of Education, Government of Bihar as per the rules.*

DISCIPLINE

All the students of the college will be under the complete disciplinary control of the administration of the college. Students must conduct themselves in accordance with disciplinary rules of the college framed and notified by the college authority from time to time.

LIBRARY

The college has a good library and the students are advised to make full use of the same. The college library is well equipped with text and reference books, Education Encyclopedias, Year Books, Electronic publications, CD-Roms, journals on teacher education etc.

LABORATORY

The college laboratories are well equipped with apparatus for experiments related to the respective education stream.

GAMES & SPORTS

The college possesses a big playground. Facilities for Yoga, Indoor and outdoor games are available. The students are expected to take part in games and sports.

PRACTICAL AND PRACTICE TRAINING

Students are required to undergo practical and practice training as prescribed by the college according to syllabus. They may be detained for practical & practice training arranged even during vacations. The practice and practical training is arranged by the college at the cost, risk and responsibility of the students.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Students are expected to take active interest in co-curricular activities like seminars, eloquence, dramatics, music, debate, etc. The college may arrange classes to pursue hobbies like photography, painting, cultural and sports activities.

TEXT BOOKS AND EQUIPMENTS

All students shall have to manage on their own accord text books which the college or the university prescribes from time to time.

Parents/Guardians are advised to see their wards to procure the text books and other necessary items to cope up with the learning process and simultaneously for the qualitative classroom interactions in particular academic standards in general.
